You may have a piano accompaniment if you want that I or someone else will play. You may make it all original or you may write a variation of some themes with differing characters that I have written and are placed on our website. It can be in any style (baroque, romantic, contemporary, etc.). As you can see, I would like this to be as free as possible, as long as some thought is put into it.

I will be available at almost any time to help you with the scoring, the refining of ideas, etc. Please feel free to email or phone me about this.

If we could try to have something by the Christmas break that would be great, and it would be nice to have a little performance on-line at that time. I do, however, see this as something that will be ongoing.
